



RESCUE PRO PFD (SAF30012)

We have received questions from customers regarding the length of the webbing harness tail when it is threaded through the quick release buckle. Some have suggested that if it is too long it could get caught up, however it has a clean end and also has the quick release system fitted.

It is our recommendation that the webbing should not be trimmed unless it your own personal PFD as any trimming could potentially affect other users or team members, which could in turn cause potential problems depending on the build of the person using the PFD.

If the webbing tail is judged to be too long, the question you may need to ask is whether the PFD is the correct size for you?

If you do trim/cut the webbing harness with a hot knife or similar or seal the end with a flame heat source, be careful not to leave a molten lip on the end of the webbing as this has been known to get jammed in the cam buckle and could prevent the release of the harness.

When attaching your Cowtail karabiner to the PFD, you must ensure it is not attached to a fixed point on the PFD, but only to a point/position that has a quick release mechanism.
